Supporting Educational Stability for Students in Foster Care

FosterVision+ is a DataZone app developed by the **Santa Clara County Office of Education (SCCOE)** to support educational continuity and timely services for students in foster care and on probation.

Built on SCCOE's Integrated Data Systems, FosterVision+ helps school districts and partner agencies coordinate information responsibly—so students experience fewer disruptions and greater stability in their education.

What Is FosterVision+?

FosterVision+ is a secure app that supports:

- Timely sharing of essential educational information
- Coordination among schools, districts, child welfare juvenile probation partners and community-based organizations
- Support in complying with state requirements for foster youth records
- Ongoing monitoring of educational progress and stability

Why FosterVision+ Matters

Students in foster care and/or probation often experience frequent school changes and service transitions. Delays in transferring records or identifying needs can disrupt learning and support services.

FosterVision+ helps by:

- Supporting swift access to educational records
- Improving visibility into enrollment and attendance
- Reducing gaps in services during school transitions
- Strengthening collaboration across agencies, schools, and community-based organizations

How FosterVision+ Supports Students

Educational Stability

FosterVision+ helps authorized staff:

- Identify when students change schools
- Access essential enrollment and attendance information
- Support timely placement and school continuity whenever possible

Supporting Legal and Policy Requirements

FosterVision+ supports compliance with **California Education Code 49069.5**, which requires:

- Prompt notification when a foster youth changes schools
- Timely access to educational records
- Coordination between educational agencies and county placing agencies

Privacy, Security, and Student Dignity

Protecting student privacy is central to FosterVision+. Only authorized users can access FosterVision+ for approved educational purposes only. The application operates within SCCOE's Integrated Data Systems and includes:

- Data Sharing Agreements with participating districts and agencies
- Role-based access controls
- Secure, encrypted data environments
- No third-party access to student data
