The Santa Clara County Office of Education (SCCOE) **DataZone MTSS App** supports districts in implementing and monitoring their tiered intervention by bringing together key student information in one secure, easy-to-use environment.

Built on SCCOE's Integrated Data Systems, DataZone MTSS helps educators coordinate supports around student needs, and monitor progress, while maintaining strong privacy protections and district control.

What Is the DataZone MTSS Application?

The DataZone MTSS application is designed to help schools:

- Set up interventions for students or groups who may benefit from additional academic, behavioral, or attendance support
- Coordinate supports across teams and programs
- Monitor student progress over time
- Use data consistently and responsibly to guide decisions

The application supports MTSS as a continuous improvement framework, not a one-time process.

Key functionalities:

- Integration with K12 Analytics and SMART
- Ability to set up and monitor interventions



Designed for School Teams

The MTSS App is built to support collaboration among:

- Teachers
- School administrators
- Counselors and intervention staff
- District support teams

Role-based access ensures that staff see only the information needed to support students appropriately.
