DataZone supports **Social Emotional Learning (SEL)** by helping schools understand patterns related to student engagement, well-being, and connection—while keeping student privacy and dignity at the center.

By bringing together selected indicators in a secure, governed environment, DataZone helps educators strengthen school climate, target supports, and monitor progress at the school and district level.

What Is SEL in DataZone?

SEL in DataZone is designed to:

- Support schoolwide SEL planning and reflection
- Help educators understand trends related to engagement and well-being
- Inform prevention and early support strategies
- Complement—not replace—educator judgment and relationships

DataZone **does not** label students or make automated decisions. Instead, it provides **contextual information** that supports thoughtful, human-centered action.

How DataZone Supports SEL

Schoolwide Insights

DataZone can help schools:

- Identify trends related to attendance and engagement
- Understand patterns that may affect student well-being
- Monitor the impact of SEL initiatives over time

These insights support school teams in strengthening universal supports and school climate.

Targeted Support Planning

For students or groups who may need additional support, DataZone helps teams:

- Review relevant indicators together
- Coordinate SEL-aligned supports
- Monitor progress and adjust strategies as needed

SEL data is always used in conjunction with professional judgment and existing school processes.

Designed for Educators and School Teams

SEL features in DataZone are designed to support:

- Teachers and classroom teams
- Counselors and school psychologists
- Administrators and support staff
- District SEL and student services teams

Role-based access ensures that staff only see information appropriate to their role.

How DataZone Supports SEL (cont'd)

Privacy, Ethics, and Student Dignity

SEL data requires special care. DataZone follows SCCOE's strict governance and privacy standards:

- Clear Data Sharing Agreements with districts
- Role-based access and limited visibility
- Secure, encrypted systems
- No third-party access to student data
- Emphasis on aggregated and trend-level views

SEL data is used only to support students, never for discipline, evaluation, or punitive decision-making.

How SEL Fits Into DataZone

SEL insights are part of the broader DataZone ecosystem, which includes:

- TK-12 analytics
- MTSS applications
- Attendance and engagement monitoring
- Secure, governed data sharing through SCCOE's Integrated Data Systems
